

SELLING CHOMETZ

Since it is prohibited to possess chometz on Pesach, we must sell to a non-Jew all chometz that will not be eaten or burned before Pesach and all chometz utensils which will not be thoroughly cleaned by then.

Since there are many legal intricacies in this sale, only a competent Rabbi should be entrusted with its execution. The Rabbi acts as our agent both to sell the chometz to the non-Jew on the morning before Pesach and also to buy it back the evening after Pesach.

Delegation of Power of Attorney for Sale of Chometz

Know ye, that I _____ fully empower and permit Rabbi Eliezer Lazaroff to act in my place and stead, and in my behalf to sell all Chometz possessed by me (knowingly or unknowingly) as defined by the Torah and Rabbinic Law, and to lease all places wherein the Chometz owned by me may be found.

Rabbi Eliezer Lazaroff has the full right to sell and to lease by transactions, as he deems fit and proper and for such time which he believes necessary in accordance with all detailed terms as explained in the general authorization contract which has been given this year to Rabbi Eliezer Lazaroff to sell the Chometz.

This general authorization is made a part of this agreement. Also do I hereby give the said Rabbi Eliezer Lazaroff full power and authority to appoint a substitute in his stead with full power to sell and to lease as provided herein. The above given power is in conformity with all Torah, Rabbinical regulations, and laws, and also in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas and of the United States.
